## A Message from the Chair

Recreation and Leisure facilities and programs are an essential component in the life of any community. They provide opportunities for learning, for doing and for relaxation. They contribute to the overall health and well being of residents, attract tourism dollars and assist in the quest to attract new residents and new businesses to the area.

The Portage la Prairie Regional Recreation Authority Inc. (PRRA) recognizes the tax-based contribution of the residents of the City and Rural Municipality of Portage la Prairie to the capital costs and operation of the PRRA. The PRRA also recognizes the need to maintain a fee structure for services and programs that ensures the greatest possible access to all members of the community.

To this end, these base fees were established with the following considerations:

- The need to provide a fee structure that is fair, equitable and reasonable to ensure that programs and facilities are open to all.
- The need to provide a fee structure that provides a level of cost recovery appropriate to ensuring financial sustainability into the future.
- The need to provide consistency throughout and among similar services, programs, spaces or facilities.
- The recognition that those receiving services should, by municipal standards, pay a “fair market value” for those services.
- The need to distribute the burden of revenue generation across and amongst the variety of user groups.
- The need to maintain similar fee structures and increases as has been past practice.

- Require facilities on a one time or casual basis

### Visitor:

An individual or organization who

- Is outside the corporate boundaries of the PRRA
- Is not using the facility for a commercial purpose

### Commercial User:

- An individual or organization who is utilizing the facility for the purpose of making a profit
